AmTrust International aims to offer niche lines and products in core accounts where it has a high degree of market knowledge and expertise.

The Internal Audit team is an established function and reflects the incredibly fast growth experienced by the business over the last few years. Internal Audit has been, and will continue to be, a key and respected agent of change in the business with access to senior management of the business. The International team covers multiple locations across London, Dublin, Milan, Stockholm, Barcelona, Nottingham, and Leeds.

Position Overview

We are seeking a Senior IT Auditor with a dynamic and agile approach, as well as excellent interpersonal skills. The ideal candidate will demonstrate a proven track record of independently planning and executing audits and possess experience in leading audit engagements and mentoring junior staff. Responsibilities include performing a broad range of internal audits and contributing to the Company's SOX Compliance initiatives. This position may require occasional travel to both regional and international offices.

Essential Job Functions:

The Senior IT Internal Auditor will lead and perform Information Technology based audits in accordance with professional standards to ensure that internal controls are appropriately designed and operating effectively. This position will have responsibility for reviewing all aspects of Information Technology (IT) including infrastructure, application controls, and IT processes. The Senior IT Internal Auditor will provide management with an independent assessment and assurance related to the adequacy, effectiveness, and sustainability of controls. The auditor's primary duties will consist of the following for assigned audits:

- Plan and perform internal audits in accordance with the internal audit plan, AmTrust audit methodology and professional standards under the direction of the IT Internal Audit Management
 - Planning – Performing process walkthroughs to identify the key activities, risks, and controls.
 - Risk Assessment – Applying risk and control concepts to assess control design and developing a test approach of the key controls.
 - Operational Effectiveness Testing – Testing the effectiveness of the key controls identified.
 - Documenting - Compiling clear and concise audit work papers and reports with conclusions that are supported by the work performed.
 - Reporting - Discussing and reporting control design deficiencies and controls not operating as designed.
- Issue Tracking - Validating with management in resolution and implementation of corrective action plans
- Be familiar with working within an audit system (e.g. Archer or equivalent)
- The auditor will also contribute to the SOX Compliance effort by performing or supporting walkthroughs and test of IT internal controls for in-scope systems and infrastructure

Other Responsibilities

- Execute application related audits to evaluate risks/controls around technology processes and systems
- Demonstrate knowledge around various applications, databases, operating systems, and network controls
- Work with process owners and management during integrated audits to ensure key risks are adequately addressed
- Working with the 2nd Line functions (e.g., IRM, ERM, Compliance) as needed
- Performing special projects as deemed necessary by management including due diligence related to potential business combinations

- Maintaining organisational and professional ethical standards and ensuring internal audit activities are carried out in compliance with the Standards, including independence and objectivity
- Working under limited supervision with moderate latitude for initiative and independent judgment
- Auditor may be required to travel up to 15% of the working year

Qualifications, Experience, Competence:

Qualifications/Experience

The successful candidate will:

- Be CISA qualified or have equivalent professional qualification
- Benefit if they have or are working toward an ACA, ACCA, CIA, CPA, or equivalent audit qualification, or be at the final year of studies
- Bachelor's or master's degree or equivalent with a major in Finance/Accounting, Management Information Systems, Computer Science, or other related field (i.e. Information Security)
- Ability to compare existing controls to standards including ISO, COBIT, and ITIL.
- Working toward one or more relevant professional certifications (i.e. CISM, CRISC, CISSP, etc.) is desirable but not required
- Have experience as an IT (internal and/or external) auditor within the general or life insurance, Lloyd's, and/or Big 4/10 environment
- Possess an excellent understanding of internal audit methodologies, risk, and control frameworks
- Demonstrate strong written and verbal communication skills
- Have a proficient knowledge of a data analytics tool (CAATs) such as ACL, IDEA, Tableau, PowerBI, etc.
- Awareness and exposure to Gen AI tools
